SIMILARITIES TO BHS

- New next to existing
- New construction by neighborhoods & other schools
- Management of bus/parent drop-off & student foot traffic
- Demolition while new & existing schools were occupied
- Temporary separation & M/E/P connections required
- Temporary bus loop & sitework phasing
- Early education & TV studio space

- Zero impacts to students & faculty
- Student & staff engagement during construction
- Expedited turnover & closeout



SIMILARITIES TO BHS

- 4 phases of occupied construction / additions
- Occupied demolition of existing structures
- Construction within 10 inches of student areas
- Early education program spaces
- Fire alarm upgrades & tie-ins
- Innovative tem framing & M/E/P phasing for cost savings
- Successful mid-year moves to maximize early turn-overs

OUTCOME

- Zero impacts to student or faculty
- Early turnover of academic & district spaces
- Improved constructability resulting in efficiency & reduced temporary conditions
